eXtensible Business Reporting Language (XBRL)

XBRL is a technology that relies upon the input of data tags to identify and describe information. The information can then be searched or downloaded into spreadsheets where it can be reorganized for analytical purposes.

XBRL is not an accounting standard and will not change the substance or format of the information disclosed in the body of reports or registration statements filed with the SEC. Rather, it requires companies to include new exhibits containing their financial statements, financial statement schedules and footnotes in XBRL format.

The various XBRL exhibits included on AK Steel's web page provide you the option of importing them into your XBRL viewer of choice. A link to the data as seen through an XBRL viewer also has been included above. That XBRL viewer transforms the XBRL exhibits included within this filing and displays their data in a traditional tabular format.
